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1. Motion to approve the agenda first Reading of Ordinance 2018-03 made by CM Burgess 2nd By VM Olano. Voice vote all in favor
 2. **First Reading of Ordinance 2018-03 FY-2019 Budget:** Read by CM Burgess.
 3. **Public Comments:**
 - Jeff Clark (Perry St.) asked to purchase large two-sided clock, that there should have been a flyer for CYTR, believe the town is withholding information it's not right to not inform resident. Didn't see it in the Sentinel announcement of the meeting of the Constant Yield Tax Rate Hearing, suggested to post on the website or newsletter, would like to suggest hiring arborist the town needs that, if there any funds to spare for the town.
 - VM Olano responded that there was a flyer that went out to resident in newsletter, for constant yield.
 - Councilmember Tavares congratulated the town for the passing of Ordinance. Is hopeful to have our support for upcoming elections, stated we are in the process of approving a \$4. 1-billion-dollar balanced budget for the county. Once it's done we would be able to inform the community that we were able to receive triple A bond rating for the County. Thanked the Council for allowing her to speak, offered her assistance. Also recall assisting the Town with request for CDBG money request to help on Windom Rd. sidewalk project and Saving Back to School for Thomas Stone Elementary. Also stated once again thanked for allowing her to speak. I'm here to serve.
 - CM Morlan asked for status on Zoning Re-write
 - Councilmember Tavares stated that they just had a public hearing and it was positive.
 - T.A Bagley stated that concern have been raised by resident that think that these 2 additional seats will benefit more so developers. How will it affect the smaller municipalities like Brentwood?
 - CM Tavares states It depend if they have money, they are 6 or 7 people running for the seat, the skew is that they'll show more preference for certain regions of the County.
 - T.A Bagley asked do you think it will affect smaller municipalities like Brentwood, North Brentwood who tend to benefit more by haven a district representative?
 - CM Tavares stated she hopes our representative will fight for us, like she would for us. With the new addition will be able to have a meeting of the mind surrounding concern that will benefit the municipalities.

4. Mayor and council Comments

- CM Harrison recommends removing section 4 from the ordinance on the part of Multiple Dwelling subject to taxation
- CM Morlan recommends removing the sections 5,6 it should just reflect property taxes, personal property and utilities.
- CM Olano asked can you specify the areas also can it be adopted and make changes later?
- T.A Bagley suggested since is the first reading, to get all the wording together of changes the need to be made and have prepared for a motion in the next reading.
- CM Burgess stated that economists might argue that there is no difference in fees and taxes, why do we need to remove the fee? Adversary in reference to Mr. Clark comments we need to find a way to post on the websites all information's related to meeting and thing of that nature.
- CM Morlan recommended to list the dates of Budget meeting on the ordinance.
