**Creating a Youth and Recreation Council in Partnership with
The City of Mount Rainier**

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Town Council have the authority to create committees and appoint citizens to those committees; and


WHEREAS, the Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission (M-NCPPC) has funds from time to time to support programs that are designed specifically for youth and teens; and


WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the Town of Brentwood, and the Mayor and Council of the City of Mount Rainier, recognize the need to fund and initiate efforts that are geared towards positive recreational outlets for youth and adults that are on-going year round.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, this 15th day of April, 2008 that a joint "Youth and Recreation Council" is hereby created for the primary purposes of developing programs and identifying funding through M-NCPPC and other agencies to support program activities for both jurisdictions.




