RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF BRENTWOOD TO HONOR AND COMMEND THE POLICE CHIEF ROBERT "BOB" ALTHOFF, OF THE BRENTWOOD POLICE DEPARTMENT

A PROCLAMATION to honor and commend Police Chief Robert "Bob" Althoff of the Brentwood Police Department on his superior experience in law enforcement especially the last six (6) and a half years for the Town of Brentwood. 


