### Year in Review

Happy New Year Brentwood! I hope 2023 brings health and happiness. As your Mayor, I am happy to report that last year was a good year for Brentwood and we continue to find new ways to grow.

Our year started by supporting the many residents still impacted by COVID-19. Weekly food drives at Town Hall, combined with free masks and COVID-19 tests for our Seniors, resulted in over 3,500 boxes of fresh fruits and vegetables given away and a more healthy and protected community.

Public safety is always a priority and this past year we saw the completion of over 4000 square feet of sidewalk improvements and installations. We also hired a new police chief who is already making a big difference in our community by creating community programming for our children and improving our police force with new technology, hiring and training.

We continue to support the arts with the installation of the area's first "Little Free Library" in Bartlett Park and the inaugural "Porchfest" which brought together over 40 musicians and residents for a day of free music and fellowship.

Community programming has always been a strength of our Town and this year was no different, with a successful Centennial Celebration and seasonal events including our Easter Egg Hunt, Back-to-School Night, Senior Luncheons, and a Visit with Santa.

Thanks to your input, your Town Council developed meaningful ARPA programs that have made a direct impact on working families and individuals living in Brentwood. Hundreds of residents have benefited from Brentwood's Affordable Housing Programs and that means hundreds of residents are going to sleep tonight in a warm house, under a dry roof, and with the knowledge that their most valuable investment – their home – is protected for years to come.

### Reseña del Año

¡Feliz Año Nuevo Brentwood! Espero que el 2023 traiga salud y felicidad. Como su alcaldesa, me complace informar que el año pasado fue un buen año para Brentwood y continuamos encontrando nuevas formas de crecer.

Nuestro año comenzó apoyando a los muchos residentes que aún se ven afectados por el COVID-19. Los obsequios semanales de alimentos en Town Hall, combinados con máscaras gratuitas y pruebas de COVID-19 para nuestros adultos mayores, dieron como resultado más de 3500 cajas de frutas y verduras frescas regaladas y una comunidad más saludable y protegida.

La seguridad pública siempre es una prioridad y el año pasado vimos la finalización de más de 4000 pies cuadrados de mejoras e instalaciones en las aceras. También contratamos a un nuevo jefe de policía que ya está marcando una gran diferencia en nuestra comunidad al crear programas comunitarios para nuestros niños y mejorar nuestra fuerza policial con nueva tecnología, contratación y capacitación.

Continuamos apoyando las artes con la instalación de la primera "Pequeña Biblioteca Gratuita" del área en Bartlett Park y el "Porchfest" inaugural que reunió a más de 40 músicos y residentes para un día de música gratis y compañerismo.

La programación comunitaria siempre ha sido una fortaleza de nuestra ciudad y este año no fue diferente, con una exitosa celebración del centenario y eventos de temporada que incluyen nuestra búsqueda de huevos de Pascua, la noche de regreso a la escuela, almuerzos para personas mayores y una visita con Santa.

Gracias a su aporte, su Concejo Municipal desarrolló programas ARPA significativos que han tenido un impacto directo en las familias trabajadoras y las personas que viven en Brentwood. Cientos de residentes se han beneficiado de los Programas de Vivienda Asequible de Brentwood y eso significa que cientos de residentes van a dormir esta noche en una casa cálida, bajo un techo seco y sabiendo que su inversión más valiosa, su hogar, está protegida en los años venideros.



**Cont...**The dream of a New Town Center continues to take shape more each day. Work is expected to be completed by Tuesday, August 1, 2023, and it will mark the first major infrastructure project by the Town of Brentwood in over two (2) decades. The New Town Center will provide community space for our residents alongside administrative workspace.

Lastly, we've been recognized by our peers as a leading Maryland community, earning multiple awards for our environmental stewardship & professional partnerships, including the Sustainable Maryland Award, Banner City Award and Tree City USA certification.

## BLACK HISTORY MONTH

Black History Month began in 1915, a half-century after the Thirteenth Amendment abolished the practice of chattel slavery in the United States of America. In that same year, a Harvard trained historian named Carter G. Woodson and a minister named Jesse Moorland founded the Association for the Study of Negro Life. This organization was dedicated to researching and promoting the achievements of Black Americans as well as those in the African diaspora.

Known today as the Association for the Study of African American Life and History, the group sponsored a national Negro History Week in February of 1926. They chose the second week of February as both Abraham Lincoln and Frederick Douglass celebrated birthdays that week. The event inspired communities all over the country to organize local celebrations, establish historical associations, and host performances and lectures.

In the decades that followed, mayors of cities across the county began issuing proclamations recognizing Negro History Week and by the 1960s (largely due to the Civil Rights Movement) Negro History Week had expanded to Black History Month on many college campuses.

President Gerald Ford officially recognized Black History Month in 1976, calling upon the public to "seize the opportunity to honor the too-often neglected accomplishments of Black Americans in every area of endeavor throughout our history".

Since 1976, every American president has designated February as Black History Month and endorsed a specific theme.

The Black History Month 2023 theme, "Black Resistance," explores how "African Americans have resisted historic and ongoing oppression, in all forms, especially the racial terrorism of lynching, racial pogroms and police killings," since the nation's earliest days.

Black History is being made all the time. The most recent close to home is our new governor. Governor Wes Moore was sworn in on Wednesday, January 18, 2023. Wes Moore is the first African American to be elected as Governor of Maryland and the third African American to hold the office in the United States history.

El Mes de la Historia Afro estadounidense comenzó en 1915, medio siglo después de que la Decimotercera Enmienda aboliera la práctica de la esclavitud en los Estados Unidos de América. En ese mismo año, un historiador entrenado en Harvard llamado Carter G. Woodson y un ministro llamado Jesse Moorland fundaron la Asociación para el Estudio de la Vida Negra. Esta organización se dedicó a investigar y promover los logros de los afroamericanos, así como los de la diáspora africana.

Conocido hoy como la Asociación para el Estudio de la Vida y la Historia Afroamericana, el grupo patrocinó una Semana Nacional de la Historia Negra en febrero de 1926. Eligieron la segunda semana de febrero porque tanto Abraham Lincoln como Frederick Douglass celebraron cumpleaños esa semana. El evento inspiró a las comunidades de todo el país a organizar celebraciones locales, establecer asociaciones históricas y presentar presentaciones y conferencias.

En las décadas siguientes, los alcaldes de las ciudades de todo el condado comenzaron a emitir proclamaciones reconociendo la Semana de la Historia Afro estadounidense y en la década de 1960 (en gran parte debido al Movimiento de Derechos Civiles) la Semana de la Historia Negra se había expandido al Mes de la Historia Negra en muchos campus universitarios.

El presidente Gerald Ford reconoció oficialmente el Mes de la Historia Afroamericana en 1976 e invitó al público a "aprovechar la oportunidad de honrar los logros de los afroamericanos en cada área de esfuerzo a lo largo de nuestra historia que con demasiada frecuencia se descuidaron". Desde entonces, todos los presidentes estadounidenses han designado febrero como el Mes de la Historia Afroamericana y han respaldado un tema específico para la Comunidad Afroamericana.

El tema de 2023 es, "Resistencia negra", explora cómo "los afroamericanos han resistido la opresión histórica y continua, en todas sus formas, especialmente el terrorismo racial de linchamientos, pogromos raciales y asesinatos policiales", desde los primeros días de la nación.

La historia afroamericana se está haciendo todo el tiempo. El más reciente cerca de casa es nuestro nuevo gobernador. El gobernador Wes Moore prestó juramento el miércoles 18 de enero de 2023. Wes Moore es el primer afroamericano en ser elegido gobernador de Maryland y el tercer afroamericano en ocupar el cargo en la historia de los Estados Unidos.

### ***VOTER REGISTRATION***

Brentwood will have voter registration days beginning February. Registered voters can participate in the upcoming town elections. Stop by and pick up a voter registration application and mail it in your- self or drop it off to town hall at 4300 39th Place, Brentwood, MD 20722. To prove you are a resident of Brentwood, bring your MVA-issued license, ID card, or change of address card, or your paycheck, bank statement, utility bill, or other government document with your name and Brentwood address. The application is located in this newsletter.

### ***CANDIDATES***

The Town of Brentwood will conduct municipal elections on Monday, May 1, 2023. Each seat of the Mayor and Council is up for election. In accordance with Charter requirements, any Brentwood resident wishing to run for an elected office must be a registered voter and have lived in the Town of Brentwood for at least one year and be above than 25 years of age. Candidates may pick up a petition from the Town Clerk beginning on February 24, 2023, and return it with at least 20 qualified signatures no later than March 24, 2023. Stay tuned for dates concerning voter registration deadlines and the Candidates Forum. You will also need to submit a candidate profile with picture for the April newsletter.

### ***ELECTION JUDGES***

Anyone wishing to serve on the Board of Elections supervisors may get additional information from the Town Clerk. Appointments will be made on or before March 1st in accordance with the charter.

### ***REGISTRO DE VOTANTES***

Brentwood tendrá días de registro de votantes a partir de febrero. Los votantes registrados pueden participar en las próximas elecciones municipales. Pase y recoja una solicitud de registro de votante y envíela por correo o déjela en la alcaldía en 4300 39th Place, Brentwood, MD 20722. Para demostrar que es residente de Brentwood, traiga su licencia, tarjeta de identificación o tarjeta de cambio de dirección emitida por la MVA, o su cheque de pago, extracto bancario, factura de servicios públicos u otro documento gubernamental con su nombre y dirección de Brentwood. La aplicación también se encuentra en este boletín.

### ***CANDIDATOS***

El municipio de Brentwood llevará a cabo elecciones municipales el lunes 1 de mayo de 2023. Cada escaño de Alcalde y del Concejo se presenta a elecciones. De acuerdo con los requisitos de la carta constitutiva, cualquier residente de Brentwood que desee postularse para un cargo electo debe ser un votante registrado y haber vivido en el municipio de Brentwood durante al menos un año. Los aspirantes pueden recoger una petición de la secretaria municipal a partir del 24 de febrero de 2023 y devolverla con al menos 20 firmas cualificadas a más tardar el 24 de marzo de 2023. Manténgase al tanto de las fechas límite de inscripción de votantes y del foro de candidatos.

### ***JUECES ELECTORALES***

- ✓ Not claim the right to vote elsewhere in the United States.
- ✓ Not have been convicted of buying or selling votes.
- ✓ Not be under guardianship for mental disability or if you are, you have not been found by a court to be unable to communicate a desire to vote.

You may submit an affidavit on a form provided by the Town Clerk attesting to your identity and place of residence.

The affidavit must be executed by a person who:

- (1) Is registered to vote in the Town of Brentwood.
- (2) Is present with you to submit the affidavit; and
- (3) Has personal knowledge of your identity and actual residence.

Such affidavit shall be executed under the penalties of perjury.

**IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR NON-UNITED STATES CITIZENS:**  
If you apply for naturalization, you will be asked whether you have ever registered or voted in a federal, state, or local election in the United States. The Town Clerk can provide a letter explaining that non-U.S. citizens who are residents of Brentwood may register and vote in Town of Brentwood municipal elections.
