



RESOLUTION 2023-05

Creating a Community Special Events Committee and Appointing a Liaison to the Committee for 2023-2025

WHEREAS, the Town of Brentwood is committed to facilitating a wide range of special events that highlight the diverse communities within the Town; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Town Council finds that special events promote the local community and character of Brentwood as well as promote the local economy; and

WHEREAS, The Town of Brentwood strives to ensure that all events are conducted in a safe and orderly fashion, weighing the social and economic benefit of the event with the general public's well-being; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Town Council finds that the Community Special Events Committee provides valuable and important review, research, and advisory functions about special event planning and programming for the Brentwood community and desires to create a permanent standing advisory committee to continue with these efforts;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, By the Mayor and Council of the Town of Brentwood that we do hereby appoint Councilmember Quianna Taylor as Brentwood Community Special Events Committee Liaison.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council that the Mission and Outlining Policy of the Brentwood Community Special Events Committee are established as follows:

MISSION:

The Town of Brentwood is committed to facilitating a wide range of special events that highlight the diverse constituency within the town. These events provide cultural enrichment, promote economic vitality, enhance community identity and pride, and provide opportunities for fundraising for the community's nonprofit agencies.

OUTLINING POLICY:

It should be emphasized that members of the Special Community Events Committee serve voluntarily and do not carry any administrative powers. The committee cannot implement its recommendations without formal approval from the committee liaison or the Mayor and Council when deemed appropriate by the Town Charter. All expenditures of funds, as well as legislative decisions, are only made by the City Council (by motion or resolution) before implementation.

SECTION TWO: CONFLICTS: All Resolutions or parts of Resolutions in conflict with any other Resolution and any of the provisions of this Resolution are hereby repealed.


