



## **RESOLUTION 2023-09**

### **Supporting an Application to the Prince George's County Planning Department's Planning Assistance to Municipalities and Communities (PAMC) Program for a Sustainability Action Plan**

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and Council of the Town of Brentwood established the Sustainability Committee with the charge to develop plans, implement programs, assist with educational opportunities, seek out opportunities to create a more sustainable environment through grants and educational opportunities, offer suggestions to improve municipal operations with sustainability initiatives that are environmentally and economically sound, and to pursue certification by Sustainable Maryland; and

**WHEREAS** The Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission (MNCPPC), Prince George's County Planning Department, offers financial assistance to municipalities under their "Planning Assistance to Municipalities and Communities" (PAMC) program for worthy planning projects that provide a benefit to the community; and


**WHEREAS**, the Town of Brentwood, Mayor, and Council have established a working relationship with and previously received assistance from MNCPPC; and


