



## Town of Brentwood

A resolution whereby the Mayor and Council encumber remaining balance American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funds for fiscal year 2025, beginning July 1, 2024 and ending June 30, 2025.

---

**Whereas**, pursuant to Town of Brentwood Charter Section 601-0, the Mayor must submit a recommended budget for Fiscal Year 2025 to the Council for its review and consideration; and

**Whereas**, the budget provides a complete financial plan for Fiscal Year 2025 and contains estimates of anticipated revenues and proposed expenditures for the upcoming fiscal year including funds provided by the American Rescue Plan Act; and

**Whereas**, recipients of ARPA funds must obligate all award funds by December 31, 2024, and expend funds by December 31, 2026 as outlined in the Obligation Interim Final Rule issued by the Treasury in November of 2023.

**Whereas**, the Revenue Replacement 2022 final rule permitted the Town to elect the Standard Allowance which allowed ARPA funds to be spent on government services throughout the period of performance.

**Whereas**, the remaining ARPA funds as of June 30, 2023 will be encumbered for spending related to government services as outlined in the guidance provided by U.S. Department of Treasury.

**Now, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT**, the Mayor and Council of the Town of Brentwood hereby endorses this Resolution, indicating their approval by signature hereof;


### **SECTION ONE. GENERAL FUND- ENCUMBERANCE**
