



RESOLUTION 2024-05

**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF BRENTWOOD AUTHORIZING THE
INSTALLATION OF A THREE-WAY STOP AT THE INTERSECTION OF
40TH PLACE AND UTAH AVENUE**

WHEREAS, section 305-15A of the Brentwood Code directs that the Mayor and Town Council of Brentwood are hereby authorized and empowered to install, remove or replace any or all stop signs deemed necessary.

WHEREAS, section 305-11 of the Brentwood Code directs whenever it is necessary for the protection of public property or desirable in the interest of public welfare and safety, the Mayor and Town Council of Brentwood may restrict or regulate the weight and type of vehicle or kind of traffic that may travel over any designated bridge, street, alley or public thoroughfare shall be plainly marked with signs or markers setting forth the restrictions of regulations.


WHEREAS, Section 305-15 H of the Brentwood Code directs to take or promulgate any other safety measures deemed necessary in the interest of public safety, health and general welfare with the Town of Brentwood.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT, the Mayor and Council of the Town of Brentwood hereby authorize the installation of a three-way stop sign at the intersection of 40th Place and Utah Avenue and the installation of bollards for a length of 15 feet on the Northwest corner of said intersection and a designated no parking lane of 40 feet approaching the stop sign on the Northeast corner of said intersection.


EFFECTIVE DATE: This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage and adoption.




