Use "salt" in moderation this winter

With winter here, it's time to get the "salt" ready to melt ice on the roads and sidewalks. Did you know that the salt we use in the winter is like what comes out of your saltshaker? Salt lowers the freezing point of the water, which means that water can't freeze at 32°F anymore so it can't stay or become ice. About 22 million tons of salt are spread on the roads in the U.S. annually. The melted ice and salt move down our sidewalks and roads and into our storm drains. Our storm drains don't have any filters between them and the local waterways, like our Northwest Branch of the Anacostia River and Chesapeake Bay. Unfortunately, this type of "salt" can harm the environment. It can kill animals in the river and bay like crabs, salamanders, frogs, and fish. It also dehydrates and kills plants and can harm soil that makes it harder for vegetation to grow. Salt can also harm our pets. Some types of ice melt are toxic when eaten, while others cause irritation to your pet's paws and skin.

How can we keep our streets and sidewalks safe while also keeping our environment safe and healthy? Purchase eco-friendly and pet-safe ice melt as safer alternatives – find them at your local hardware store. Apply it to your sidewalk *before* a weather event instead of at the end of a storm and use only enough to get the job done – don't over-salt. There's also ice melt made from beet juice, sugarcane molasses, and cheese brine! This year, try a little beets or cheese with your "salt."

Este invierno use "sal" con moderación

Con el invierno aquí, es hora de preparar la "sal" para derretir el hielo en las carreteras y aceras. Sabías que la sal que usamos en invierno es como la que sale de tu salero? La sal reduce el punto de congelación del agua, lo que significa que el agua ya no puede congelarse a 32 ° F, por lo que no puede permanecer ni convertirse en hielo. Alrededor de 22 millones de toneladas de sal se esparcen anualmente en las carreteras de los EE. UU. El hielo derretido y la sal se mueven por nuestras aceras y carreteras y llegan a nuestros desagües pluviales. Nuestros desagües pluviales no tienen ningún filtro entre ellos y las vías fluviales locales, como nuestra Rama Noroeste del Río Anacostia y la Bahía de Chesapeake. Desafortunadamente, este tipo de "sal" puede dañar el medio ambiente. Puede matar animales en el río y la bahía como cangrejos, salamandras, ranas y peces. También deshidrata y mata las plantas y puede dañar el suelo que dificulta el crecimiento de la vegetación. La sal también puede dañar a nuestras mascotas. Algunos tipos de hielo derretido son tóxicos cuando se comen, mientras que otros causan irritación en las patas y la piel de tu mascota.

Cómo podemos mantener nuestras calles y aceras seguras y, al mismo tiempo, mantener nuestro medio ambiente seguro y saludable? Compre hielo derretido ecológico y seguro para mascotas como alternativas más seguras: encuéntrelos en su ferretería local. Aplíquelo en su acera antes de un evento climático en lugar de al final de una tormenta y use solo lo suficiente para hacer el trabajo, no le eche demasiada sal. ¡También hay hielo derretido hecho de jugo de remolacha, melaza de caña de azúcar y salmuera de queso! Este año, pruebe un poco de remolacha o queso con su "sal".
