TOWN OF BRENTWOOD ORDINANCE 2011-02

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE FISCAL YEAR 2012 BUDGET

WHEREAS Chapter 6 (“**Finance**”) of the Brentwood Charter authorizes the Council to prepare, deliberate, and adopt an annual budget whose fiscal year begins on July 1st and ends on June 30th of the following year; and

WHEREAS Section 601.0 (“**Submission of budget**”) states that “At or before the first Council meeting in April of each year, the Mayor shall submit to the Council a proposed budget for the ensuing fiscal year”; and

WHEREAS Section 602.0 (“**Budget**”) states that the “budget shall provide a complete financial plan for the budget year and shall contain estimates of anticipated revenues and proposed expenditures [...where the] total anticipated revenues shall equal or exceed the total of the proposed expenditures”; and

WHEREAS Section 603.0 (“**Budget adoption**”) states that “Before adopting the budget, the Council shall hold a public hearing thereon after notice thereof in some newspaper or newspapers having general circulation within the Town...Where the Council shall increase the total proposed expenditures, it shall also increase the total anticipated revenues in an amount at least equal to such total expenditures”, with the proposed budget “prepared and adopted in the form of an ordinance”, with a favorable vote of at least a majority of the total elected membership of the Council [being] necessary for adoption”; and

WHEREAS Section 404.0 (“**Ordinances**”) states that “No ordinance shall be passed at the meeting at which it is introduced”, but such ordinance “shall be passed or passed as amended, or rejected, or its consideration deferred to some specified future date” at any regular or special meeting of the Council “held no less than six or more than sixty days after the meeting at which any ordinance was introduced”; and

WHEREAS former Brentwood Mayor Xzavier C. Montgomery-Wright submitted a preliminary proposed fiscal year 2012 budget at the Council Meeting of April 5, 2011 and a revised fiscal year 2012 budget at the Council Meeting of April 12, 2011; and

WHEREAS the Brentwood Council discussed and amended the proposed budget at public hearings on the following dates: April 5, 2011; April 12, 2011; April 18, 2011; April 21, 2011; May 10, 2011; May 17, 2011; May 19, 2011, May 24, 2011

WHEREAS the final proposed budget for fiscal year 2012 is a complete financial plan for the budget year containing estimates of anticipated revenues and proposed expenditures where the total of the anticipated revenues equal or exceed the total of the proposed expenditures; and

WHEREAS the fiscal year 2012 budget, in the form of an ordinance, received its first reading on May 17, 2011, and its second reading on May 24, 2011

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that on this date of June 7, 2011, the Mayor and Council of the Town of Brentwood adopts the budget, tax, and fee rates for the Fiscal Year 2012. The real property tax rate is set at \$0.382 per \$100 of assessed value, and personal property tax rate is set at \$1.00 per \$100 of assessed value.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the aforementioned rates shall become effective 30 days following its enactment, but no earlier than July 1, 2011.


