MOSQUITO SPRAY AND LARVAE PROGRAM (FROM OFFICE OF CODE ENFORCEMENT)

Thanks to Councilmember Morlan for her research.

Mosquito Control Spraying:

A mosquito only needs a teaspoon of water to lay their eggs and while there are so many preventative measures each of us can practice, mainly don't keep standing water around (flower pots, kiddie pools and outside toys, bird baths, trash can lids, and clogged gutters) the reality is that many aren't mindful to reducing the mosquito population. The health risk with the West Nile Virus and Zika Virus is a real consideration in particular to the very young and senior citizens.

The Town will be participating in the Community Mosquito Spray and Larvae program administered by the Maryland Department of Agriculture. Spraying will likely begin in late May and will continue through the summer. The product used for the ground spraying is a synthetic parathyroid diluted in mineral oil. The application is sprayed at night when mosquito activity is at its highest. The night time spray schedule also serves to protect pollinators that are active during the daytime. We do have some resident beekeepers that can request exemption or the MDA recommends the hives be covered during the spraying.

Any resident can request to be exempt from the mosquito control spraying on their property (300 ft. buffer) by notifying The Dept. of Agriculture with a copy to the Town of Brentwood.

PROGRAMA DE CONTROL Y ELIMINACIÓN DE MOSQUITOS Y LARVAS (DE LA OFICINA DE APLICACIÓN DE CÓDIGOS)

Fumigación contra mosquitos:

Un mosquito sólo necesita una cucharadita de agua para poner sus huevos y mientras existen tantas medidas preventivas que cada uno de nosotros puede tomar –principalmente no dejar el agua estancada en macetas, piscinas infantiles, juguetes exteriores, baños de aves, tapas de basura y las canaletas obstruidas– la realidad es que muchos no están atentos a la reducción de la población de mosquitos. Hay un riesgo para la salud en cuanto al virus del Nilo Occidental y al virus Zika y realmente se lo debe considerar en particular para los niños muy pequeños y los ancianos.

El municipio participará en el programa comunitaria de fumigación contra mosquitos y larvas administrado por el Departamento de Agricultura de Maryland (MDA). La fumigación probablemente comenzará a finales de mayo y continuará durante el verano. El producto que se utilizará en la fumigación es una paratiroides sintética diluida en aceite mineral. Se aplicará por la noche cuando la actividad del mosquito está en su nivel más alto. El horario nocturno de aplicación también sirve para proteger a los polinizadores que están activos durante el día. Tenemos algunos apicultores residentes que pueden solicitar una exención o la MDA recomienda que se cubran las colmenas durante la aplicación. Cualquier residente puede solicitar una exención del control de mosquitos en su propiedad (una zona tampón de 300 pies) al notificar el Departamento de Agricultura y con una copia enviada al municipio de Brentwood.
