



**Town of Brentwood  
Resolution 2017 – 06**

**WHEREAS**, Section 502.1 Charter of the Town of Brentwood that “On or before March first in each and every year that there is a regular Town election, the Mayor and Town Council shall appoint one qualified voter of said Town, not holding any other office thereunder, to serve as a chief election judge, who shall act as registration official and judge of any election held during the two years succeeding his appointment”; and

**WHEREAS**, Section 502.2 of the same requires that The Mayor and Town Council shall also appoint two (2) qualified voters of said Town, not holding any other office thereunder, to serve as election officials for the two years succeeding their appointment, to assist the chief election judge in his duties during the course of any election held during their term”; and

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and Council have appointed Anne Christine Warden as the Chief Election Judge to begin term on March 1, 2017, Brian Szabo and Pierre Malochee as Election Judges to begin terms upon their swearing in.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Mayor and Council of the Town of Brentwood authorize the above-named individuals to act in accordance with the duties set forth under the Charter.
