



RESOLUTION 2018-03

Resolution of the Town of Brentwood Establishing Business License Fees in Accordance with Ordinance 2017-02

WHEREAS the Mayor and Council of the Town of Brentwood desires to regulate the establishment of commercial and other for-profit establishments and practices within the Town boundaries; and

WHEREAS the Mayor and Council has added Chapter 59 ("BUSINESS LICENSES") to the Brentwood Code, which delineates regulations effecting Brentwood businesses; and

WHEREAS the Mayor and Council has authorized the adoption of an annual business license fee to be adopted and amended from time to time by resolution;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Mayor and Council of the Town of Brentwood establishes Business License Fees to be assessed as outlined in ATTACHMENT A of this Resolution:

SECTION TWO: CONFLICTS: All Resolutions or parts of Resolutions in conflict with any other Resolution and any of the provisions of this Resolution are hereby repealed.

SECTION THREE: SEVERABILITY: If any section or portion of a section of this Resolution is found to be invalid, unlawful or unconstitutional, it shall not be held to invalidate force or effect of any other section or part of this Resolution.

TIER I BUSINESSES	\$1,500
After hour clubs/Junkyards/Storage facilities/ Gun Retailers/Fortune tellers, clairvoyants & phrenologists	
TIER II BUSINESSES	\$300
Banks, trust companies and building associations, mortgage companies and small loan companies	
Drug Stores/Retail Merchandise Stores/Home Improvement including general contractors, fabricators, electricians, plumbers	
New and/or Used Car Sales/ Garage and automobile repair shops/ Parts and Distributors/Gasoline or Service Stations/Parking lots for occupancy of trailers, trucks or buses	
Restaurants	
Real estate and insurance sales and service	
Trades or businesses for which annual fees are not set forth in the above schedule shall pay annual business license fee	
TIER III BUSINESSES	\$200
Barbers/Salons/Beauty Parlors; Cleaning, pressing, tailoring, cobblers & shoe repair shops/Rug cleaners, Upholsterers, Uniform Shops	
Merchants, including general stores, bakeries, dairies, coal & ice dealers, fruit & vegetable dealers & soft drink merchants	
Job printing and publishing	
TIER IV BUSINESS	\$100
Hackers and peddlers (e.g food trucks and ice cream vendors)/ Magazines, book salesmen/ Individuals soliciting the sale of services (e.g., roofing, security)	

SECTION FOUR: EFFECTIVE DATE: This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage and adoption.
